

English

Read Write Inc- Children will continue to all access the Read Write Inc programme that we follow as a school. They will receive daily sessions that will focus on their phonic understanding at the level that they have been assessed at. They will follow a set programme where they will be introduced to a new sound each day. The children will have the opportunity to read aloud in class and listen to a story being read to them. They will develop their comprehension skills linked to the story that they have been reading.

In English writing lessons the children will be focusing on the structure of sentence writing including punctuation as well as developing sentences using adjectives. They will be using different stories to support their structure of writing where they will be looking at descriptive writing, narrative writing and non fiction writing

Every week the children will bring home a reading book based on the level that they have been assessed at as well as the reading book that they have read that week in class. Spellings will be set on

Art and design: Drawing: Exploring line and shape

In this unit the children will explore and create maps through various art forms, including drawing, working in relief, print making and designing stained glass. The children will develop their skills in sorting, designing and evaluating.

Computing

The children will continue to use our Purple Mash scheme and will focus on creating digital art using different tools available to them. They will save and retrieve their work from their own folders. Online safety - the children will look at self image and identity and how people can act differently online.

PE - Gymnastics - children will focus how they can link basic movements together so their routines can be completed with flow.

Dance - The children will be looking at using their bodies to make big and small movements linked to a stimulus of animals. They will create movements with rhythm using different motifs of animals.

History - How am I making History?

The children will be gaining an understanding about events that have happened in the past in their own lives as well as some significant events from the past. They will begin to understand how to read a timeline and use the terms 'beyond living memory' and 'within living memory' and

In this new unit, children explore keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things. Children will clap, sway tap or sing a rhythm in time with pulse. They will also try to keep the pulse while playing musical

Science

Animals including humans - All About Me

In this unit the children will learn how to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body. The children will also be able to match which part of the body is associated with each of the five senses.

Maths -

As a school we are following the White Rose Maths scheme.

Year 1 - The children will be consolidating their understanding of numbers to 10. They will focus on addition and subtraction to 10 using resources such as base 10 and tens frame to support them. They will also be completing a unit on shape where the focus will be on the names and properties of simple 2 D and 3 D shapes.

Year 2 - will continue focusing on their understanding of tens and ones. They will use this understanding to support their unit of addition and subtraction. They will have the use of base 10 as a resource. they will be crossing the tens boundary and using base 10 to help them with this understanding. They will also complete a unit on shape where they will be learning all the different properties of 2D and 3D shapes,

RE - Incarnation

In this unit the children will learn that Christians believe Jesus is God's son and that he was born as a baby in Bethlehem. The children will learn that the Bible points out that his birth showed that he was extraordinary and he came to bring good news. Christians celebrate Jesus' birth; Advent for Christians is preparing for Jesus' coming.

PSHE - Health and wellbeing

The children will learn to understand emotions, identify strengths and qualities, learning why we wash our hands and had do so effectively.
