A **settlement** is a place where people live. These can be **rural** or **urban** areas.



Northumberland is a **county** within the North-East **region**.



A **landmark** is an object or a feature of a landscape or town that is very important and makes a place easily recognisable.



A **physical feature** would be here even if there were no people (e.g. seas). A **human feature** is something that is made or built by humans. (e.g. houses)



A **compass** is a magnetic instrument used for finding direction.



Land use is how an area of land is used.



Eastings are numbered lines that run vertically on a map.

Northings are numbered lines that run horizontally on a map.

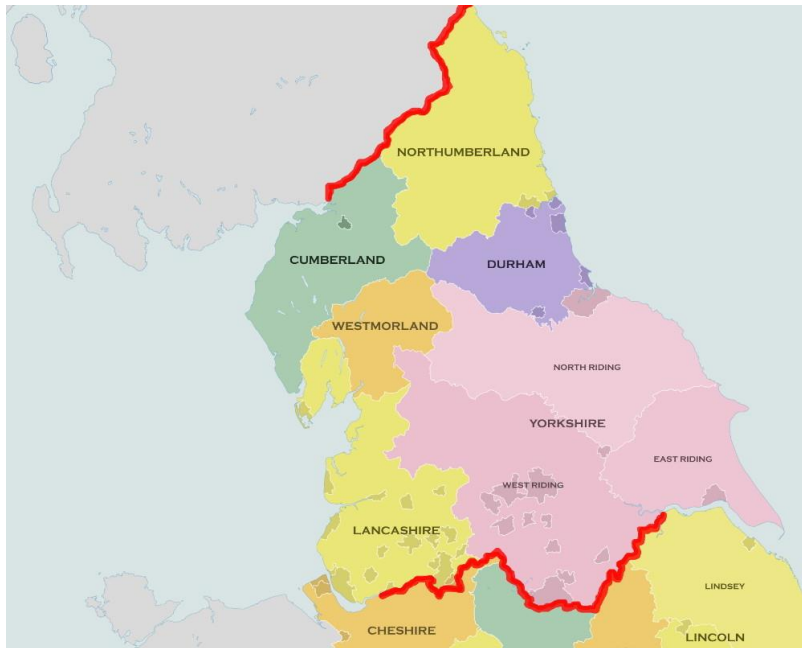

The **United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland** is an **island country in Europe**.
