

English

Read Write Inc- Children will continue to all access the Read Write Inc programme that we follow as a school. They will receive daily sessions that will focus on their phonic understanding at the level that they have been assessed at. In Year 2, children that have completed the RWInc program will now access shared reading lessons. The children will have the opportunity to read aloud in class and listen to a story being read to them. They will develop their comprehension skills linked to the story that they have been reading by answering questions using taught skills. In English writing lessons the children will be focusing on the structure of sentence writing including punctuation as well as developing sentences using adjectives. They will be using different stories to support their structure of writing where they will be looking at descriptive writing, narrative writing and non fiction writing. Every week the children will bring home a reading book based on the level that they have been assessed at as well as the reading book that they have read that week in class. Spellings will be set on Edshed for homework each week.

Design and Technology: Textiles - Puppets

In this unit the children will be taught how to join fabrics together using pins, staples or glue. The children will then design their own puppet using a template. They will join the two puppets' faces together as one and then decorate the puppet to match their design. The unit will finish with the children evaluating their own work.

Computing - This unit introduces children to coding using the block coding tool, 2Code. Children will explore simple instructions and relate this to code blocks. By the end of this unit, children will be able to make a simple program.

PE - Gymnastics - Linking - the children will be reviewing and revisiting skills that have been previously taught and developing these to be able to link them together to develop sequences of movements.

Dodging In this unit the children learn about the importance and purpose of dodging. They explore dodging and learn how to dodge effectively. The children will then learn how to apply the technique into games.

Athletics - The children will also start to look at the activities that will become a focus for sports day. These will include running, jumping and throwing.

Geography

The children will be focusing on their understanding of the seven different continents and the 5 surrounding oceans. They will be focusing on Asia and will be looking at our local area and comparing it to Shanghai. They will be looking at human and physical features within both areas and revisiting their skills of maps

Music—Singing (Theme: On This Island)

In this unit the children learn folk songs and create sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes; seaside, countryside and in the city. The children will be provided with the opportunity to perform their compositions to each other.

PSHE - Economic wellbeing

In this unit the children will develop an understanding of what money is and where it comes from; recognising the difference between needs and wants, learning how to manage money. They will also learn about where to save their money.

Maths - As a school we are following the White Rose Maths scheme.

Year 1 children will be focusing on multiplication and division. They will look at counting in amounts of 2's, 5's and 10's. This will then lead them into their understanding of their times tables. They understand about grouping and sharing of amounts to support the calculation of division. The children will also learn about fractions ensuring that they understand about the whole amount and then look at halving and quarters. They will use amounts as well as shapes to help them to understand this. Year 2 will be looking at measurements including mass, capacity and temperature. They will also be learning about fractions with a focus on amounts of shapes as well as fractions of shapes. Year 2 will also be continuing their learning of their times tables of the 2x, 5x and 10x.

RE - Who is Jewish and how do they live?

In this unit the children will learn to understand that there are a number of religions in the world.

By the end of the unit they will be able to give examples of how people use stories, texts and teachings to guide their beliefs and actions, individually and as communities.

Science—Seasonal Changes

In this unit the children will learn how to observe changes across the four different seasons. The children will observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies during the different seasons.
