#### What to wear for P.E.

- White T-shirt
- Black plain shorts.
- Plimsolls for indoor sessions only.
- Trainers or plimsolls for outdoor sessions
- Tracksuit bottoms and sweatshirt for outdoor work in winter.
- Close fitting shorts and T-shirt to be worn for all P.E lessons.

All children are expected to wear the correct kit for both indoor and outdoor P.E. You will be told when your child has P.E. at the beginning of each year, however we recommend that P.E. kit is brought to school; on Monday and left at school throughout the week.

#### For safety:

All jewellery must be removed for P.E and swimming and given to the Class Teacher for safekeeping. This includes earrings, watches, necklaces and rings.

If your child has had their ears pierced recently they should be taped during the six-week healing period. Following this, earrings must be removed by either the child or their parents prior to the lesson. Staff are not able to remove or tape earrings.
