Children who are due to start in Reception September 2022



Parents/carers of children who are due to start their Reception year in September 202 2 will be able to apply for their preferred schools from Monday 1st November 2021.

Reception admissions to school are coordinated by Northumberland County Council, (NCC). They open a portal on their website at the start of November in the academic year preceding children's start in September. Parents indicate their

school preferences on the portal which closes on 15th January 2022. NCC contact parents with the results of their application on National Offer Day (15th April 2022.) The full timetable is shown below.


