#### Flu Immunisations

We have received confirmation from the Immunisations Team that they will come to Shanklea on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November 2021 to give the nasal/needle-free flu vaccinations to children in Reception to Year 6. The team collected completed parental permission forms on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September. In previous years the team have accepted late forms so our Office Team are still collecting forms but we cannot guarantee that they will be accepted by the NHS Team. We have received notification from the British Fatwa Council that the nasal flu vaccine containing porcine gelatine is permissible for use within Muslim communities. A copy of their communication may be obtained from the office.



### Robinwood Residential Trip - Year 5



Parents and carers of our Year 5 children were emailed a letter and information pack this week about a residential visit to the Robinwood Activity Centre in Alston. This is a fantastic trip which develops children's confidence and a range of skills as well as being great fun. #### **Parents in the Services**



If any parents or carers are a member of the armed forces can you please let school know before 6<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

The Service Pupil Premium is money provided by the Department for Education to schools in England who have children of Regular Armed Forces personnel among their pupil population to provide additional (mainly pastoral) support. Pupils with a parent on full commitment as part of the Full Time Reserve Service (FTRS FC) are also classed as Service children. Service Pupil Premium is currently £310.00 per Service pupil and is paid directly to schools.

The information recorded by schools regarding Service status is protected and data regarding individual children is not shared outside the school

### **Christmas Cards**
