School Meals September 2022

Families are reminded that Universal Free School Meals are limited to children in Reception and Year 1 and Year 2. Therefore, if your child will be in Years 3 and above from September they will not be eligible.

They may however, qualify for income related Free School Meals. To find out if you are eligible, you would need to apply for Free School Meals on the NCC website at the link below. Shanklea School Uniform

The Department of Education (DfE) recommends that all schools adopt a uniform or dress code. It is therefore our policy that all children wear uniform when attending school or when participating in an organised event outside normal school outside.

Our uniform policy is based on our belief that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearances
- Engenders a sense of community and belonging toward school
- Is regarded as suitable wear for school and is considered as good value for money by parents/carers
- Ensure rapid identification of pupils

You may remember that we revised our policy following our recent questionnaire for parents and carers. A copy of the revised policy will be sent to families with this newsletter as a reminder.

NHS mental health services and autistic children and young people

Healthwatch Northumberland have been in touch with us to say they have been hearing from local families that some NHS mental health services aren't working for them. To understand what is happening, they are asking parents to tell them about their family's experiences of these services (School Health, CYPS and Primary Mental Health). They want to know what is working well and what could be better.



Parents can tell the team about their experience online, or by getting in touch in a way that suits them. Children do not need to have a formal autism diagnosis – they also want to hear about those currently being assessed or where there is an indication of autism.

















What parents tell the team will be included in a report to those who pay for and provide these services, along with recommendations of how services could be improved for children and young people. It will be anonymous and they will ensure families cannot be identified.

Holiday Activities

The Northumberland wildlife trust has been working with a great community group over the past 9 months to develop a trail, created to spark children's imagination around the themes of folklore and nature. We will email other information about holiday activities separately.


