Breakfast and Out of School Clubs

Bookings may now be made online on the School Gateway for Breakfast and OOSC in June and July. June bookings made before Wednesday 25th May 2022 will not be liable to a late booking fee. If you need to make a June booking after this date you will need to contact our Office Team or complete a paper form which can be obtained from outside the office.

Please note: when booking on the School Gateway you need to make a booking on the relevant club (for example June 2022 OOSC 1st child), **NOT just make a payment**. This is because we need to know which session your child will be attending.

It is also important to note that you should always prebook our before and after school provision. We will always try to help in emergencies but we need to know how many children will be attending in advance of the session so we can ensure staff ratios are met and sufficient resources are available.


