We hope that you will be able to come along to your child's new classroom on Wednesday 13th July 2016, 3.30-4.30p.m to meet your child's new


teacher. This is is an opportunity for you to find out about routines, information about homework and lots more. You can also ask any questions you may have.

Everyone had a phenomenal experience at Edinburgh and we were delighted to receive this message from our coach driver:






Hi to all,


