Airport Arrangements:

This is a chartered flight so we propose to meet inside the airport entrance at **5.45am**. The entrance is the old entrance on the opposite side to Greggs.

Duty Free:

Children will be able to look in duty free. However, we are advising against children spending money in the airport. They can bring sweets to eat on the flight and purchase refreshments.

Packed Lunch

Can children please bring a packed lunch for the first day. We can't take liquids through Security so **no drinks please** but can children bring some money to buy a drink.

Spending Money, Passports and EHIC Cards:

Packing

Bag Pack



We have arranged for our skiers (staff and children) to take part in a bag pack at **Morrisons in Blyth on Saturday 25th February, 10-4pm**. This is to raise funds for activities during the week. We hope everyone can come along. Can you please complete and return the slip overleaf to indicate what times your child will be able to come along.

Children should wear their Shanklea Skiers Hoodies. Some guidelines are included overleaf. The address is Morrisons, Regent Street, Blyth, NE24 1LQ.

HOW TO HAVE A SUCCESSFUL BAG PACK

DO

- Phone on the day to confirm you are coming. Let us know when you will arrive, how many and for how long. 10am- 4pm on a Saturday works well, probably 11am to 3pm on a Sunday.
- Report to Customer Services on arrival. You will be asked to sign the visitors' book and wear badges before you start packing. Give the name of the group leader to customer services so that they know who to contact if there is a problem.
- **If you intend using the car park for more than 3 hours YOU MUST GIVE YOUR REGISTRATION NUMBER TO MORRISONS OTHERWISE YOU MAY INCUR A PENALTY CHARGE.**
- Pack at every other operational till, a maximum of 8 tills. Wear t-shirts with logos to identify yourselves, have clearly labelled buckets. Children packing must have a minimum of 1 adult supervising every 3 children. No more than two people packing at a checkout- one can hold open bags while the other puts items in. You might only need 4 to six packers for the first hour or so. Maximum limit 16 packers at any one time.
- Ask politely if a customer wants bags packed- a smile and eye contact helps. If customers don't want to use your service, stand back to that they have room to pack themselves. Thank customers for their contributions.
- **The better you pack, the more money you will raise- be quick but careful.** Heavy items at the bottom and crushable items (crisps, bread, eggs etc) on the top. Frozen/chilled goods in the same bag, fruit and veg together. Get children to practise before they arrive.
- When not packing, use the end table as a "base" in the café. You can put coats etc in a trolley in the lockable trolley park (£1 deposit).
- Sign out at customer services desk before you leave.
- Send an email or text to let us know how much you have raised.

DON'T

- Use tills 5, 6, 7 or 8- they are too close to the customer service desk
- Eat and drink while packing
- Collect with buckets anywhere else in store
- Go shopping while in store to bag pack
- **Smoke directly outside store- there is a smoking shelter round the back**
