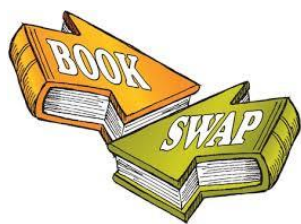

Illness

You may be aware that there have been some cases of chicken pox across school. We follow guidance from NCC and NHS England to prevent any spread of any infectious diseases. If your child becomes ill with an infectious illness such as chicken pox, impetigo, conjunctivitis, etc please contact our Office Team if you are in any doubt as to when your child can return to school.

We ask that all children who experience sickness or diarrhoea remain at home until they have been clear of symptoms for 48 hours.

Booking Out of School Club

Our Breakfast and Out of School Clubs continue to be very popular and families are regularly booking and paying for places on the School Gateway.

To avoid confusion, please note the following:

- ✚ If you are booking OOSC places at a session for more than one child in your family please book the eldest child under the "1st Child", next eldest under "2nd child" and so on.
- ✚ If you are only booking one of your children into an OOSC session please book that child under "1st child" regardless of whether they are the eldest or youngest in the family.
- ✚ You can book places online up to the publicized closing date each month. After that date you need to complete a paper form (available from outside the office) or contact our Office Team who will make the booking for you. Bookings made this way will attract a £2 late booking fee.
- ✚ Please refer to the back of the booking form for the Terms and Conditions of our clubs. For example, refunds are only given if the child is ill.

Extra-Curricular Clubs

Clubs started this week but will not take place in the final week of term. Tennis, Computing and Football clubs will not take place on Thursday 16th June due to staff training. They will be on as normal the following week.

Please ensure your child attends regularly each week and is collected promptly from after school extra-curricular clubs from the yard at 4.30pm.
