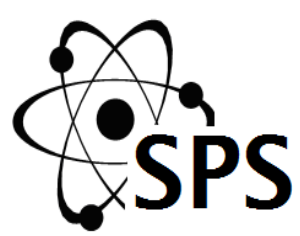


# School Organisation

fourteen Classes plus Nursery and Squirrels

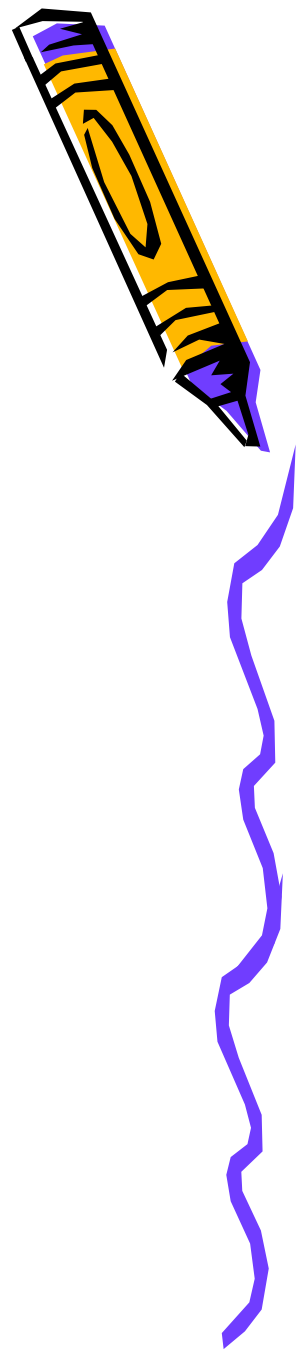
- Early Years Unit with 3 teachers and 9 Teaching assistants

(Smoother transition Nursery to Reception age)





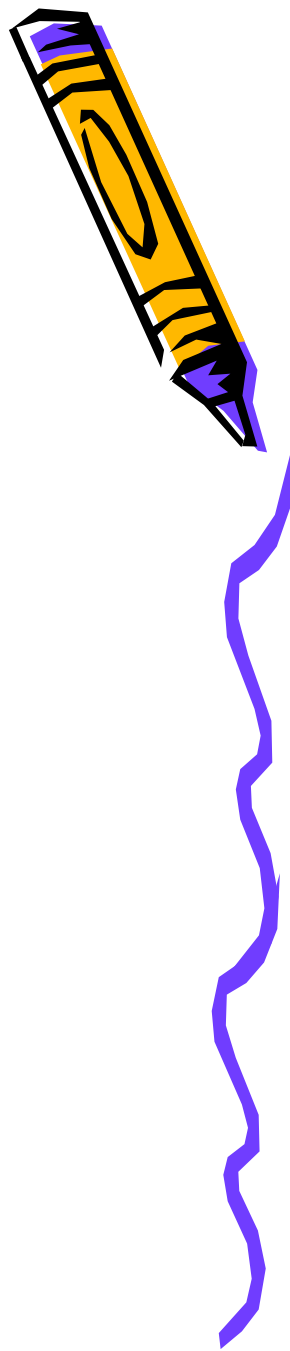

Each term we will hold a parents workshop where you can enjoy taking part in craft activities with your children. This years workshops involved Christmas Crafts and Easter fun.

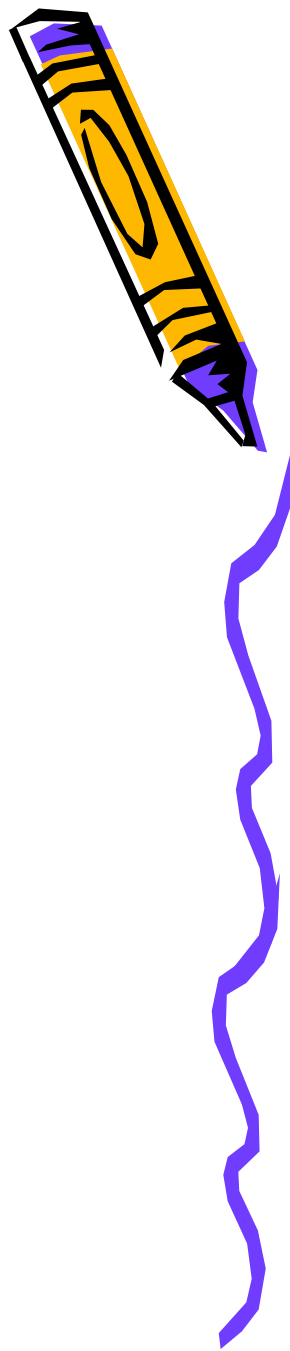

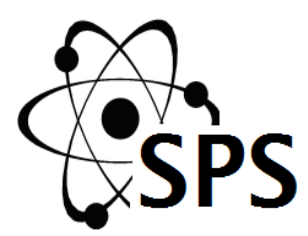

- Payment - Dinners, milk, trips



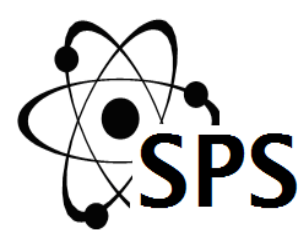

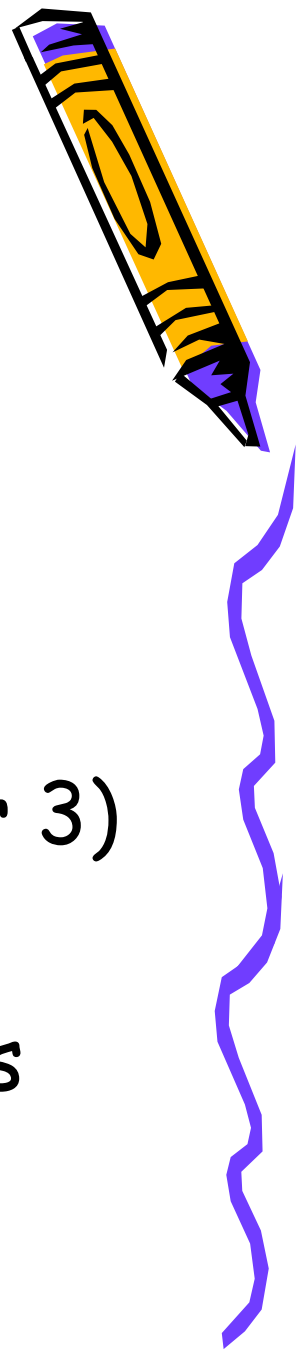
- Please speak to someone without delay your child's class teacher is available before and after school, please as when you drop your child off in the morning or ring up for a chat
