





- Early Years Unit with 3 teachers and 9 Teaching assistants

Each term we will hold a parents workshop where you can enjoy taking part in craft activities with your children. This years workshops involved Christmas Crafts and Easter fun.





 Headteacher Mrs Brown is available each morning on the yard or by appointment of needed.


