Learning the French language at Shanklea

Heights and Weights Programme - Reception and Year 6 children

Each year registered nurses and health care providers come into schools to check height and weight information for pupils in Reception and Year 6 as part of the National Child Measurement Programme, (NCMP). Share a Story Month - May 2022


