

It is lovely to see everyone back this week and settling quickly into class again after the half term break.

The Portal for requesting a Reception place in September 2022 is now OPEN





Reception admissions to school are coordinated by Northumberland County Council, (NCC). They open a portal on their website at the start of November in the academic year preceding children's start in September. Parents indicate their school preferences on the portal which closes on 15th January 2022. NCC contact parents with the results of their application on National Offer Day (15th April 2022.) The full timetable is shown below.

1 November 2021	Online applications Online Admissions Portal for First and Primary school admissions will open on the 1st of November 2021. You need to register as a new user if you haven't used the Portal before. If you've forgotten your password, click on forgotten password link) - (for late applications see below). You must complete an application for a place in a Reception class even if your child attends the school nursery or pre-school setting. Please be aware there are two school in Ponteland with similar names and addresses. Ponteland Primary (Pele Trust) and Ponteland Community Primary					
	(previously Ponteland Middle School). Make sure you are careful about which school you select. leaflet on how to apply and portal user guidance to help you with your application					
15 January 2022	Closing date for all applications to be received by the Local Authority					
15 April 2022	National Offer Day. E-mails sent to those parents who applied online and who requested to be informed by email. Parents who applied on a paper form will have a letter sent out to them today					
2 May 2022	Deadline for parents to refuse the school place.					
8 May 2022	Any places that become available are allocated in criteria order (on time applicants)					
29 May 2022	All remaining places allocated on a first come first serve basis.					
31 December 2022	No waiting lists held by the Local Authority after this date.

Home Learning

Parents and carers were sent a copy of our Home Learning Policy on Friday 5th November. This outlines the learning that can be undertaken at home with children (Years 1 to 6) and has been compiled taking account of educational research and the views of parents and staff.

Parents of children in KS1 and KS2 will also have received a copy of an enrichment grid with optional activities for you and your children to undertake. Spellings and number facts will also have been shared with you:

















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- On Tapestry for EYFS;
- On paper For KS1 and
- Via Google Classroom for KS2.

We hope that these will provide those parents who wish to do so with appropriate and purposeful activities without putting unnecessary pressure on other families.

We would encourage all parents to continue to focus on reading regularly with their children throughout their primary education.

School Priorities

We have always recognised the importance of reading to our pupils. Therefore, one of the priorities we have set for ourselves at Shanklea this year is to further develop the reading curriculum to enable all pupils to enjoy reading at an appropriate level for their age. This allows them to access all their other learning successfully.

One way in which we aim to do this will be working alongside families to provide reading opportunities at home and in school. Over the next few weeks we will be letting you know about ways you can get involved with this. Over the year, you may also see challenges and activities designed to promote reading.
