Shanklea Jubilee Lunch

Parents and carers will be invited to join their children for **lunch** on **Friday 27th May 2022** to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. This event will be dependent on the weather as we are planning a picnic garden party on the school field.

Children should come to school dressed in red, white **AND** blue or dressed for a garden party to celebrate the jubilee. Children can order a picnic lunch via School Grid and can bring a picnic blanket if they'd like to.

Parents are invited to join their children for a picnic on the field and there will be traditional family games to play, organised by our Year 6 children. Parents will need to bring their own food. Reminder – no nuts or traces of nuts please.

The timings are as follows:

11.30 – 12.30 Reception, Years 1 and 2

Parents/carers should arrive at 11.20 and set up on the field. Signs on the field will indicate where the children will be brought to. Lunchtime supervisors will bring lunches for the children at 11.45. Individual bags will be labelled with children's names.

At 12.30 parents/carers will leave and are able to take their children home early if they wish. Children going home must be signed out. All children remaining will be taken back into school.

12.45 – 1.45 Years 3, 4, 5 and 6

Parents/carers arrive at 12.35 to set up on the field. Children will come out to meet parents and lunchtime supervisors will bring lunches out around 1pm in individually labelled bags.

At 1.45 parents/carers will leave and are able to take children home earlier if they wish. All children must be signed out and any remaining children will return to school.

KS2 Children will only be able to leave early if they are signed out by their parents/carers.

Children in main school will receive their copies of the book 'Queen Elizabeth: A Platinum Jubilee Celebration' shortly.
