


Ryan's swimming is going from strength-to-Thanks to his hard work and perseverance he has now achieved his 15 and 20m certificates. Well done, Ryan.

Thank you to Mrs Gaultier and Mrs Baxter for all their hard work in preparing for these wonderful events.


