This week, Mr Burn, a Safety and Safeguarding specialist visited our Year 6 children to share a very interesting and enlightening talk on how to keep themselves

safe in the community and online.

The discussion covered lots of important areas including advice on how to best respond in particular situations.

One of the difficulties children face is peer pressure and the children were shown a useful app that can help them get out of a challenging situation by giving peers the impression that their parent, or other authority figure, has contacted them and they need to leave immediately.

There are different apps that can be used, depending on the type of phone your child has. One example for android phones is Fake Call and SMS For Android. A simple web search will help you to identify the one that is most appropriate for your child.

Important Online Safety Warning Snapchat Location Tracker

We would like to share some important information with parents that we have discussed with our older children this week.

There has been a recent Location Tracking update on Snapchat that allows users to follow their friends' locations and have their own location followed by their friends.

Clearly, this information could represent a potential risk to children's safety if it were to fall in to the wrong hands.

Any parents whose children use Snapchat can protect their child by ensuring that the settings are set to "Only me (ghost mode)." This prevents other people from tracking your location.

Please note that you have to zoom out of the screen on the camera to access this part of the app.

We strongly advise that parents continually monitor children's use of the internet and apps that their children use.
