Safety Messages

Dogs

Please do NOT tie up dogs near the school gates or let your dog (however friendly) jump up at children. Some of our children have allergies and others are very anxious around dogs. Thank you

Water Bottles

Please do NOT put water bottles in the children's' book bags with their school books. We have had a few this term which have leaked.

Safety Around School

We continue to receive complaints about inconsiderate and/or unsafe parking and driving around our school. We are sorry to have received reports from local residents about unsafe and inconsiderate parking, people leaving engines idling for long periods and even blocking people from accessing their own drives.

We urge all Shanklea families to consider children's safety and respect others when dropping off and collecting children from school.

Please note that Section 42 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 prohibits leaving your engine on (engine idling) when it is not needed. Air pollution from exhaust fumes can also be problematic, especially for people with asthma or other breathing problems.

For children's safety, parents and carers MUST NOT park in the school car park at the start and end of the school day without prior agreement (due to a specific need) from Senior Leadership.

Thank you for your support in ensuring that our children stay safe and that Shanklea maintains our reputation as a good neighbour.
