

Evaluation of Early Years Pupil Premium 2016-2017

Disadvantaged Cohort Performance (2 pupils)

In 2016 -2017 the outcomes at the end of EYFSP show significant improvement in all areas of the Early Years curriculum (Prime and Specific areas).

The whole cohort of Shanklea EYFSP pupils achieved a good level of development (GLD) of 83.6% as compared with the national average of 69.3%.

100% of Pupil Premium pupils at Shanklea reached the expected standard or above across the EYFSP curriculum.
