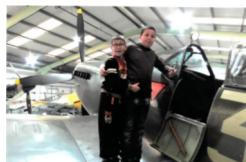
D-Day 75

- Smart school shoes, preferably black

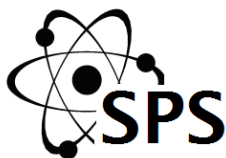
In the summer term (until the end of the school year) children have the option to wear either short grey trousers or checked summer dresses.
